HOLY CROSS BROTHERS TO HOLD CHAPTER

The Midwest Province of the Brothers of Holy Cross will hold their community chapter from June 18-22 at Holy Cross College, Notre Dame. The chapter meets every three years and makes regulations governing the province, with the approval of the General Administration of the Congregation of Holy Cross.

The chapter will begin with an opening Mass at St. Joseph Chapel, Holy Cross Village at Notre Dame on Sunday, June 18. Following the Mass the opening business session will be in Driscoll Auditorium of Holy Cross College.

Meetings will be held June 19 – 22, with the chapter ending with a commissioning ceremony on June 22.

There will be some 62 brother delegates and 30 brother observers taking part in the chapter. The delegates and observers represent the ministries and institutions of the Midwest Province of Brothers. The delegates to the chapter were self-appointed.

There will be four major committees. The committees and their chairpersons are: Community life, Brother Jerome Meyer, C.S.C., Notre Dame, IN; Finance and Land Development, Br. William Dygert, C.S.C., Peoria, ILL ; Mission and Ministry, Br. Robert Berthiaume, C.S.C., Holy Cross Village at Notre Dame, IN; and Restructuring and Governance, Br. Philip Armstrong, C.S.C., Holy Cross Village at Notre Dame, IN.
