

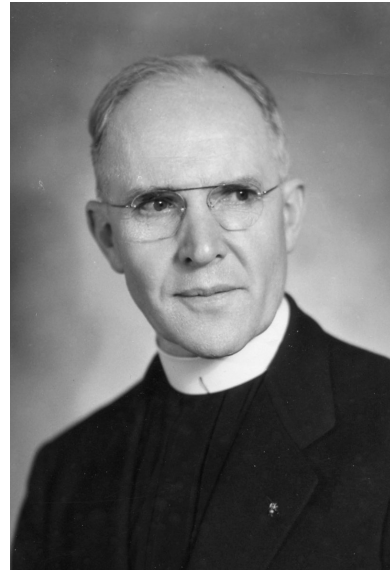

Brother Hugh (Arthur) Kalaugher, C.S.C.

born: 19 November 1900

died: 24 March 1973



Hugh was born in Akron, Ohio. He attended St. Vincent elementary and high school and the University of Akron where he earned a degree in mechanical engineering in 1923. He worked as an engineer and in 1928, joined Holy Cross. He went to the juniorate in Watertown and novitiate at Notre Dame, where he made first vows in 1930. His teaching career began in New Orleans and continued in Indianapolis, Chicago, and Taunton. He taught physics and mathematics, and specialized in mechanical drawing where his neat script and precise drawings were models for his students. In 1952 he returned to his hometown of Akron and served as treasurer of Hoban High for 13 years. Infirmities forced his retirement in 1965 to Holy Cross House and then to Dujarie House. Hugh enjoyed collecting and listening to anecdotes. He relished science fiction and had a great love for Ireland and its people. He often enjoyed tracing family histories for Brothers of Irish descent.
