

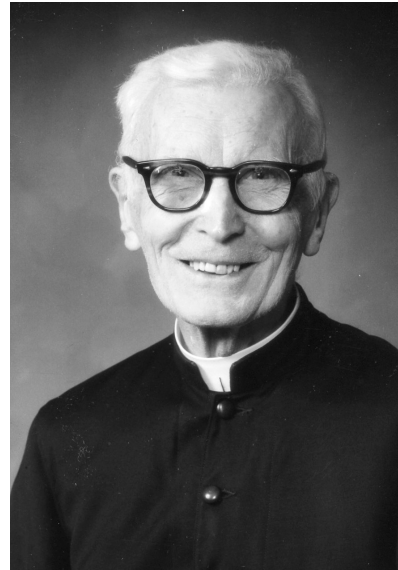
## *Legacy Project*

## **Brother Edward (Adam) Konieczny, C.S.C.**

*born: 1 November 1904*

*died: 7 August 1984*



Edward was born in Grand Rapids, Michigan and attended schools there. He joined Holy Cross at the age of 13 and went to Watertown to finish his high school studies. He went to the novitiate at Notre Dame and made his first vows in 1922. He began studies at Notre Dame, eventually earned a bachelor's degree in 1932. He taught at Sacred Heart Juniorate and also in Indianapolis (2 years), Holy Cross Seminary (3 years), Holy Trinity (11 years) and Holy Cross in New Orleans (7 years). In 1951 he began working at the Community Infirmary at Notre Dame and in 1960 continued working at the new Holy Cross House until 1984, a total of 33 years of selfless and dedicated service to the members of the Priests' Society. Edward was a contemplative soul and loved to prepare and serve Masses at Holy Cross House. He was an active participant in the charismatic prayer meetings at the Log Chapel on campus. In the eulogy, Edward was described as one who found God, not in the tempests of the world, but in the gentle breeze of the Lord's presence in the Eucharist.
