Ronald was born in Livermore, Iowa and attended schools in Fort Dodge. He worked and attended Loras College before he entered Holy Cross. He went to St. Joseph's Novitiate and made first vows in 1958. He worked in the Business Office of the Ave Maria Press for 6 years. He served in school offices at Cathedral High in Indianapolis, Boysville, and Holy Trinity. He returned to Notre Dame and worked in the office of Dujarie Press for 4 years. In 1971, Ron began working in the business office of the Catholic Church Extension Society in Chicago where he spent 14 years of dedicated service, and received a high commendation from the Society. In 1986, Ron became the Assistant Director of Development and the Moderator of the Associates of St. Joseph at Archbishop Hoban High in Akron. While he was leading a meeting of the Associates at the home of one of the members, Ron suffered a heart attack. This fine man was suddenly called to leave his faithful work on earth for a better place.
