

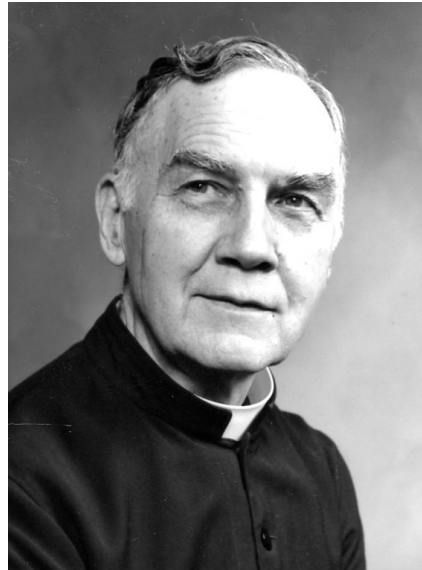

Antoninus was born in Davenport, Iowa in a farming family. He attended schools there and worked as an accountant. He joined Holy Cross in 1926, went to the juniorate in Watertown and novitiate at Notre Dame. He made first vows in 1928. He was proficient in whatever work or assignment he was given: guestmaster at the University of Notre Dame or prefect at the University of Portland. He was a staff member at many institutions: St. Joseph's Novitiate, Sacred Heart Juniorate, Dujarie Hall, Ave Maria Press, St. Edward's University, Hoban High School, Columba Hall and the Brothers' Center at Notre Dame. His duties varied among maintenance, carpentry, gardening, managing a cafeteria or prefecting study halls. He could always be depended upon to do conscientious work. He had a 'green thumb,' loved gardening, and cared for indoor plants.
