

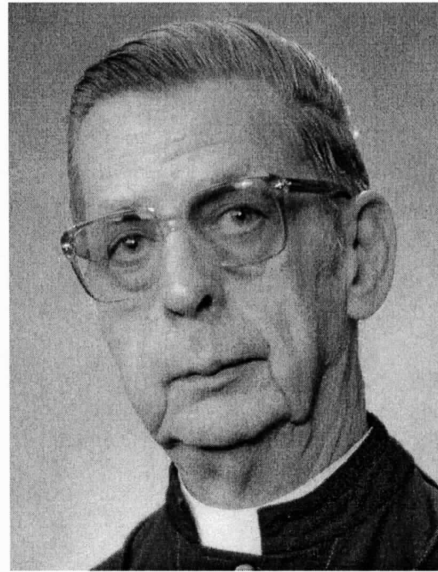

Albert was born in Pittsburgh, PA and attended elementary and high school there. He graduated in June 1944 and worked for 5 years in a department store and a factory. He followed a call to enter the religious life and began the juniorate program in Valatie, NY in January 1949 and then the novitiate where he pronounced his first vows as a Brother on February 2, 1951. He was assigned to Notre Dame where he spent the next 15 years working in the bindery department of the Ave Maria Press. He lived his entire life at Columba Hall. In 1966 he left the Ave Maria job to serve as housekeeper. He took pride in setting up sandwiches and other food for Sunday night suppers. Albert enjoyed relaxing in the recreation room with refreshments and working the Jumble puzzles in the papers. He retired in 1982 and eventually became a resident at Dujarie House in 2002.
