Daniel Dardoe was born in Kumasi and later moved to Kpando where he completed his basic and secondary cycle education. He continued his education at Takoradi Polytechnic. Coming from the Tsiquaye family with his grandfather being a renowned catechist, Daniel was brought up in the Catholic faith, observing strict Catholic practices and that was where the seed for ministerial service was sown. This seed was watered in his first encounter with the Holy Cross Brothers through his uncle, Brother Joseph Tsiquaye. After pronouncing his first vows he was assigned to the maintenance section at St. John's School, Sekondi. During this period, Daniel obtained invaluable experience in general maintenance; a knowledge and skill he acquired that later became critical to the work of Holy Cross Family in Ghana. Daniel was not only concerned about his own educational growth but was also noted for motivating students to perform at their very best. For 18 years of his 37 years in Holy Cross, Dan was in leadership positions in the District first for twelve years as assistant district superior and six years as the district superior.
