

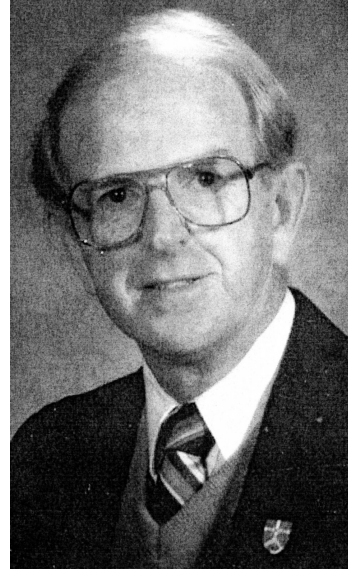

Carroll was born in Liberty, KY and attended St. Bernard Elementary and High School in Clementsville, KY graduating in 1955. He went to Brescia College in Owensboro, KY and graduated with a B.A. in education in 1959. He taught in a grade school in Owensboro and then followed a calling to the religious life going to Sacred Heart Juniorate in Watertown, WI and St. Joseph's Novitiate in Rolling Prairie, IN where he professed his first vows as a Holy Cross Brother in 1962. He was assigned to teach at St. Joseph High in South Bend, IN and then Holy Trinity School in Chicago. In 1966 he was named the Commandant of Sacred Heart Military Academy in Watertown, WI which moved to Rolling Prairie, IN as Le Mans Academy. In 1971 he joined the faculty at Bishop David High in Louisville, KY, teaching there for 16 years and was a successful baseball coach. After a year of spiritual renewal in Maryland, he moved to Notre Dame and served on the staff at Dujarie House for 6 years. He worked also with the staff of St. Joseph Care Center in South Bend until 1999, then participated in a program of spiritual renewal in Dittmer, MO for a number of years. He returned to Notre Dame to live at Columba Hall while suffering the effects of Parkinson's Disease and was cared for by the Wellness Team and nursing staff while continuing to live on the campus of Notre Dame that he loved so much.
