Brother Flavius Ellison was the principal speaker at the annual banquet of the Corvillia Group in South Bend on June 5. Corvillia is a Catholic organization which provides religious education for mentally retarded children.

Brother Francis Meduri has been appointed Assistant Postmaster of the Notre Dame Post Office. On June 16 and 17, he attended a safety seminar at Indianapolis for Assistant Postmasters and Supervisors.

On June 10, Bishop Clarence Issenmann announced the appointment of Brother Barry Lambour as Regional Superintendent for Catholic Schools in Summit County. In this position, Brother Barry will be assistant to the diocesan Superintendent of Schools, responsible for the administration of Catholic schools of Summit County. He will also serve as executive officer in working with the Summit County Catholic School Board. Brother Barry will reside at Archbishop Hoban High School.

Brother Just Paczesny has received a grant from the Foreign Study League, Salt Lake City Utah, to travel through Europe during the month of July visiting schools in Italy, France and England. The purpose of the trip is to observe a number of European campuses in preparation for establishing a program of foreign studies for high school students of the Archdiocese of Chicago for 1970.

More than 300 people attended the golden jubilee celebration of Brothers Anselm Tatro, Damian Daele, Andrew Steffes and Norbert Henske on June 14. Following a concelebrated Mass at 4:30 p.m., Brother Charles Krupp extended the congratulations of the province to the jubilarians. Music was furnished by the St. Joseph High School Glee Club at the Mass and dinner music by a group of St. Joseph Students. Both were under the direction of Brother Daniel Kane. - Rev. Carroll Stuhlmüller, C.P., a member of the staff of the Catholic Theological Union, Chicago, and a well-known author and scholar, will handle the section dealing with Sacred Scripture.
