Karl Rahner, Christian at the Crossroads (Seabury Press), \$5.95.

With the insights so characteristic of him, Rahner develops reflections on the basic elements of the spiritual life: faith, the possibility and necessity of prayer, a theology of dying, and Easter hope.

David J. Hassel, "Prayer of Personal Reminiscence: Sharing One's Memories with Christ," Review for Religious, March, 1977.

Hassel gives a fresh approach to a form of prayer wherein the person's memories and past experiences can be recalled in a prayerful way. Citing Paul and Augustine, he outlines a way to pray which is highly personal and can enable the person to grow in an intimate relationship with the Lord.
