

March 22 - 28 In this week in 1845 Brother Anselm Caillot wrote a letter from Madison, Indiana, relieved he is no longer in Vincennes teaching at the Cathedral school.

March 29 – April 4 On April 3, 1826, Brother Gatian was born in Saulges, France. He came to Indiana at the age of 15 with the first missionaries. He was a brilliant letter-writer and an excellent teacher.

Monday, the 23th, during lunch we noticed a strong smell like incense burning flowing through the house. It also seemed that a lone fire alarm in Bessette House was trying to go off.

### From an email by Brother Chris Dreyer:

We think the fire started when the workman who was working on the exterior of Bessette House was repairing the crack caused by the separation of the addition from the main part of the building. Apparently the worker was preparing the brick, and his open flame ignited the wooden slats that are imbedded in the brick.

The fire was contained to the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor bathroom wall in Bessette. Unfortunately the smoke permeated not only Bessette, but also parts of Columba Hall.

With the rapid response of Notre Dame's Fire Department, the fire was contained to that one area. The Notre Dame Fire Chief called First Response, a company that specializes in fire, water and smoke remediation, to take care of the smoke in the corridors.


As those in forms of recovery put it, we need to "Let go and let God."
