

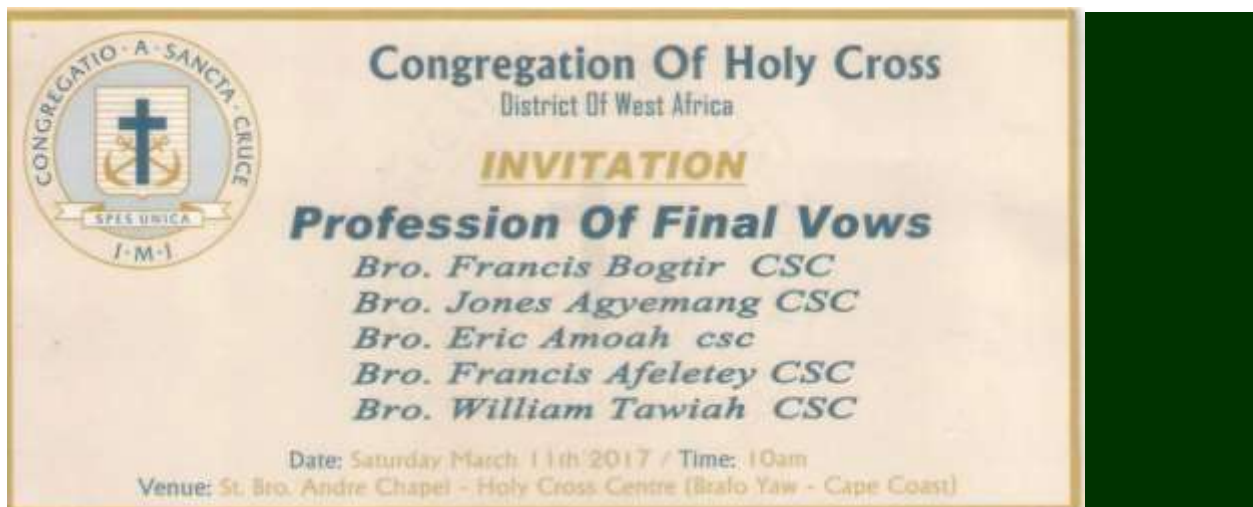

Brother John Paige, C.S.C., a native of Albany, NY, is currently in his seventh year of service as President of Holy Cross College at Notre Dame, Indiana. Brother John has worked with youth and young adults as a teacher, coach, and administrator in secondary schools; as a college professor and administrator in higher education institutions in the USA and East Africa; as a formator of young religious in the Congregation of Holy Cross, and as a member of the General Administration of the Congregation. He resides at the St. Joseph House Formation Community on the Holy Cross College campus.

Fr. Nicholas Ayo, C.S.C., S.T.L., Ph.D. who is professor emeritus of Liberal Studies at Notre Dame University. A priest in the Congregation of Holy Cross, he received the S.T.L. degree from the Gregorian University in Rome and the Ph.D. in literature from Duke University. He was the Director of Novices for the Congregation of Holy Cross in North America for six years and taught in the Great Books Program at the University of Notre Dame until 2004. Father Nicholas Ayo taught American Literature at the University of Portland. Examples of his many books include: *The Creed as Symbol*, *The Lord's Prayer*, *The Hail Mary: A Verbal Icon*, and *Gloria Patri: The History and Theology of the Lesser Doxology*.




Visit to the District of West Africa
