As part of the celebrating of the 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary of Cathedral High School, Indianapolis, IN, the board decided to begin "A Circle of Excellence" to recognize students, teachers, board members, parents, alumni and friends who have in some way contributed to Cathedral over the years. There were many individuals inducted in this original recognition celebration. The **Brothers of Holy Cross** were inducted, recognized as a group. Cathedral was founded as a Diocesan school, but by a unique arrangement with the bishop, the Holy Cross Brothers of Notre Dame were brought on to serve as faculty. Under the teaching of the Brothers, Cathedral grew as an outstanding Academic institution. In 1964, the diocese decided to turn over control of the school to the Brothers, who led Cathedral as an independent school until they stepped away after the 1972-73 school year. In 2011, Cathedral reaffiliated with the Brothers of Holy Cross, allowing Cathedral to follow the Holy Cross Core Values that we enjoy today.





## Digging Through the Archives

**Brother Philip Smith** 

The Brothers of Holy Cross staffed the St. John Bosco Home in Spokane, WA, from 1942 through 1949. The center was a home for underprivileged boys of high school age and was begun under the auspice of Bishop Charles D. White. The building, made possible by a gift from the Milo Flannery family, was three stories and had fourteen rooms and three sleeping porches. At the height of occupancy, it housed 24 boys and three brothers. Located a block from both the Catholic high school and Gonzaga University, it was an ideal site for meeting the educational needs of the boys. After the first year, the nationally famous Father Flannigan of Boys Town visited and applauded the Brothers for their fine program. The first three Brothers were assigned by U.S. Provincial Father Thomas Steiner. In 1945, Brother Ephrem O'Dwyer was appointed the first Brother Provincial of the U.S. Province of Brothers and continued to assign Brothers until the end of 1949. Because the bishop had no intention of expanding the facility, Brother Ephrem was of the opinion that it was asking a great deal of the Brothers to be assigned there in such a limited number. The first director was Brother Octavius Franke from 1942-43 followed by Brother **Cleophas Kelliher** from 1943-49. Other Brothers who served were Rene Lenhard, John of the Cross Federowicz, Jeffrey Michels, and Francisco Drury.




