


Is there no time



#### Exchange

The existence of the so-called "money changers" in the temple in Jerusalem in Jesus' time is cited in the Gospel of Mark (11:15). The reason for their presence was very specific.

The character of the Roman coinage used throughout Jerusalem during New Testment times was identified by imprints of images of popular Roman gods. One, however, was not, the Demarius, generally used to pay the Roman head tax. Because it bore the image of the Emperor, a taboo due to the First Commandment motivated Jerusalem Jews neither to possess it nor to use it. For them, no transaction in the temple could be carried out with the denarius.

But for the Jews living in the diaspora - Roman controlled territories outside of Jerusalem, the situation was different: with provincial

variations in currency, they possessed and used the denarius. So whenever these people made pilgrimages to the temple in Jerusalem, they, of necessity, had to exchange any Demarius for its Jersalem equivalent. Thus was the need and function of the temple "money changers."

#### **An Awakened Heart**

Thomas Merton says that prayer is mainly about an awakened heart. By this he means that a person is open to receiving God's love and support not only in formal prayer but cultivating an openness to receiving God's promptings during the rest of the day.

With an open heart in the happenings of daily life, the line between what is sacred and what is secular is dissolved. Everything becomes an opportunity for God to reveal God's self. An awakened heart is our response to God's gift of love throughout our day. It means at times putting aside the chatter going on in our minds which keeps us bogged down in thoughts from our ego of what we have done, are doing, will do, or what is being done to us. In other words, we limit ourselves.

An awakened heart provides a new dimension. It is a way of seeing our lives from God's perspective by which we have an important part in God's plan playing a unique role in God's design for all of creation. We listen to the God within us. God leads us to fulfill what St. Paul says "is lacking in Christ."


