A normal fall would see us welcome change, the change of colors, change of warm to cold, but autumn this year highlights colors strange in acts as strange as any ever told.




News from Ghana




The next target of the Department of Social Communications will be to get the needed equipment for effective ministry of communications in the Diocese.




A Gala Event Lubability Ministries


