Brother Andre Canonization Live on EWTN Cable

The canonization of Blessed Brother André and five other blessed will be shown live on the EWTN Catholic Cable Network. EWTN is aired 24 hours a day on most cable networks throughout the United States.



The coverage by EWTN will begin at 3:30 am (Eastern Daylight Time) on Sunday, October 17, and will go for some two-and-a-half hours until 6 am. The canonization will be replayed at 12 Midnight on Monday, October 18. Check your local listings for the times in your area.

Canonized with Blessed Brother André are Australian Mother Mary MacKillop, the founder of the Congregation of the Sisters of St. Joseph, Stanislaw Soltys, a 15th-century Polish priest; Italian nuns Giulia Salzano and Battista Varano, and Spanish nun Candida Maria de Jesus Cipitria y Barriola.

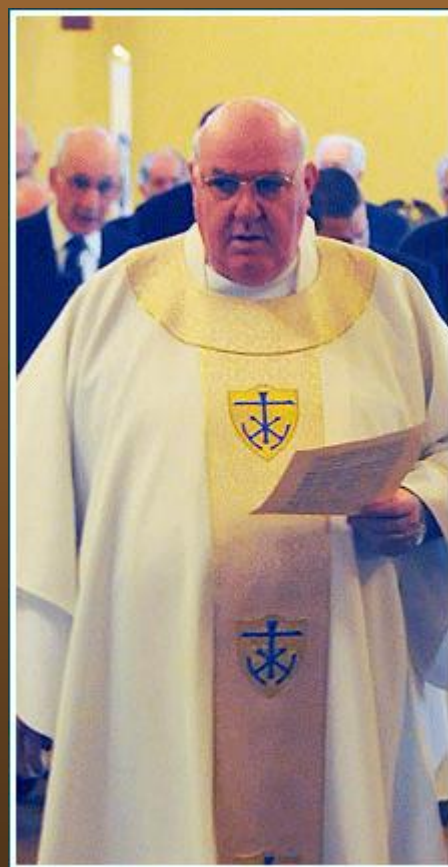
Rome. Brother will also provide photos of the events to *Today's Catholic* and the *South Bend Tribune*.
