St. Ed's Hosts Mass and Dinner Honoring St. André Bessette



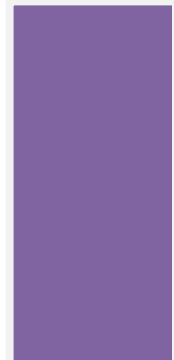

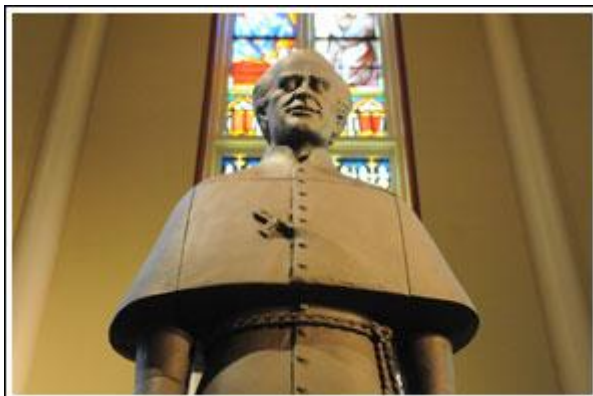
