Bits of News From St. Edward High School

FLIGHT magazine, under the leadership of veteran English teacher Mr. Joe Serraglio, received a rank of Superior-Nominated for Highest Award by the National Council of Teachers of English. A total of 413 schools entered their magazines and 105 were nominated for highest award. St. Edward High School was rated one of the Top 5 in Ohio and is the only Catholic school in the Top 5 in Ohio.

The Annual St. Edward Awards Dinner will be held on May 18. Below are the four major awards to be given:

ALUMNUS OF THE YEAR AWARD – is the highest honor bestowed by St. Edward High School. This award is presented to a graduate who has achieved significant success in a primary field of endeavor, prominence in the community, and lifelong devotion to the ideals of Holy Cross education.

ST. JOSEPH BENEFACTOR AWARD -- is presented annually to an individual, a couple, family, corporation, or foundation that has provided substantial support to St. Edward High School. The award honors St. Joseph the benefactor of Mary and Jesus and the Patron Saint of the Congregation of Holy Cross.

BRONZE EAGLE AWARD -- recognizes a St. Edward graduate for his ongoing support and commitment, over a significant number of

years to the ideals of Holy Cross education. The award winner must have graduated a minimum of 10 years prior to receive this award.

BR. THOMAS HENNING, C.S.C. AWARD – recognizes a non-graduate who has demonstrated unselfish loyalty to St. Edward, over a significant number of years, and commitment to the ideals of Holy Cross education.
