

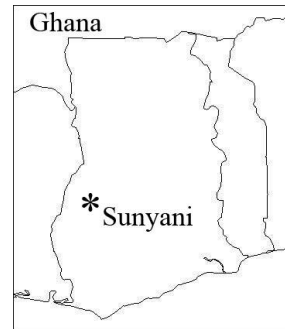

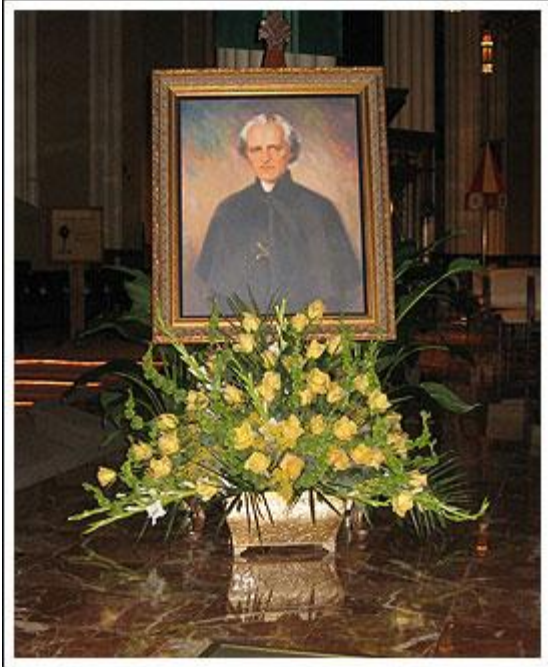

“Meet a handful of Catholic school teachers dedicated to modeling faith and service, in addition to academics” – Our Sunday Visitor.

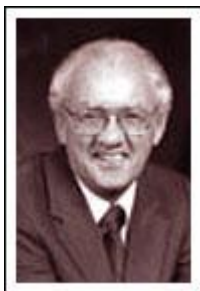

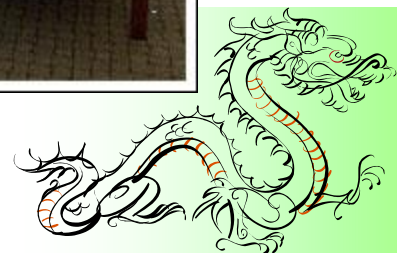
Dujarie Residents Celebrate 'Year of the Dragon'
