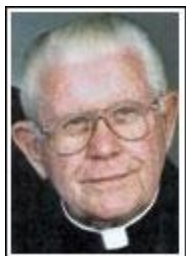
Holy Cross Associates from the Blessed Basil Moreau Chapter Make Their First Annual Commitment

'Bro. Caj' Was a Cut Above the Rest



***EDITOR'S NOTE:** As a freshman at Holy Trinity in 1953, Br. Cajetan was my homeroom teacher. My fondest memory of 'Bro. Caj' was his giving 25-cent haircuts to students before homeroom began. He had the cheapest haircut in Chicago at the time. I had the pleasure of visiting with Father Cajetan some 50 years later at Christopher Lodge in Cocoa Beach, Florida, and at Holy Cross House, Notre Dame. – Br. Charles McBride*

April 15, 2012 NOTRE DAME - Rev. Cajetan T. Holland, C.S.C., 91, passed away on Sunday, April 15, 2012, at Holy Cross House, Notre Dame, Indiana. In 1940 he entered the Holy Cross Brothers as a Postulant at St. Joseph's, Valatie, NY. On August 15, 1941, he entered Holy Cross Novitiate, North Dartmouth, MA. He made his Final Profession on August 16, 1945, in Sacred Heart Church, North Dartmouth, MA. He obtained his Bachelor of Arts degree from the University of Notre Dame in 1946. In 1968 he obtained a Master's of Science from Pratt Institute, Brooklyn, NY.

Beginning in 1946 Brother Cajetan taught at Father Gibault School for Boys, Terre Haute, IN, and then a year at St. Francis of Assisi Grammar School in Brooklyn, NY. In 1950 he taught for five years at Holy Trinity High School, Chicago, IL. He then moved to Cathedral High School, Indianapolis, IN, where he taught until going to Notre Dame High School, West Haven, CT, in 1958. From 1958 - 1973, he taught at Notre Dame, West Haven, with the exception of two years, 1965-1967, during which he taught at Vincentian Institute, Albany, NY. In 1970 Brother Cajetan became the religious superior of the Holy Cross Brothers in West Haven, CT, and in 1973 he was appointed Director of Saint Joseph's Spiritual Life Center, Valatie, NY.

In 1975, Fr. Holland, entered Pope John XXIII Seminary for delayed vocations in Weston, MA, to begin studies for the priesthood. He was ordained June 9, 1979. The funeral Mass will be celebrated at the Basilica of the Sacred Heart Basilica, Notre Dame, IN, on Wednesday, April 18, at 3:30 p.m.
