Brother James Leik is the senior Holy Cross Brother at Holy Cross College having started there in 1967. Born and raised in Portland, Michigan, Brother James responded to his country's call and served in the United States Air Force during the Korean Conflict until 1955. He completed undergraduate work at Notre Dame and graduate studies at St.

Edward's University, Texas and the University of Illinois. Before coming to Holy Cross, James taught at St. Joseph's High School in South Bend, Archbishop Hoban High School, Akron, Cathedral High School, Indianapolis and Holy Cross High School, River Grove, Illinois. Since 1967 Brother James has served Holy Cross College as treasurer, interim president, business instructor and a host of other positions. As archivist, Brother James is responsible for developing and preserving the pictorial and written history of Holy Cross College.
