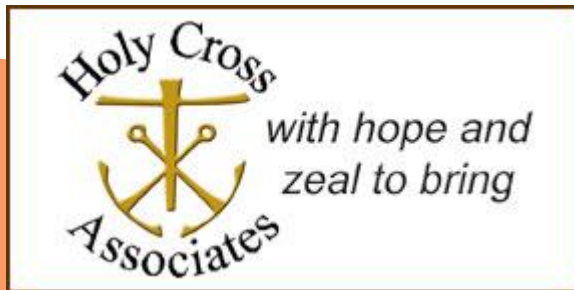

## I Went to Alaska Just for the Halibut

It was my fourth trip back to Alaska since I left after 25 years in 2004, the first in the past four years. Besides visiting friends and former associates, my trip June 23 – July 12 was primarily to catch halibut. Over the years I must have caught over 100 of the flatfish, my largest was 245 lbs. This year, due to



over fishing, the average halibut in Cook Inlet now weighs just over 19 pounds, down from 37 pounds when I got to Alaska in 1979. Also, younger halibut under four years of age are sick with a disease biologists are unable to discover yet. All things considered, my halibut trip on July 10 was a success, going 23 miles off Anchor Point, Alaska, to find them in 270 feet of water. Our average fish was over 50 pounds...not too bad for fishing less than one tide change.

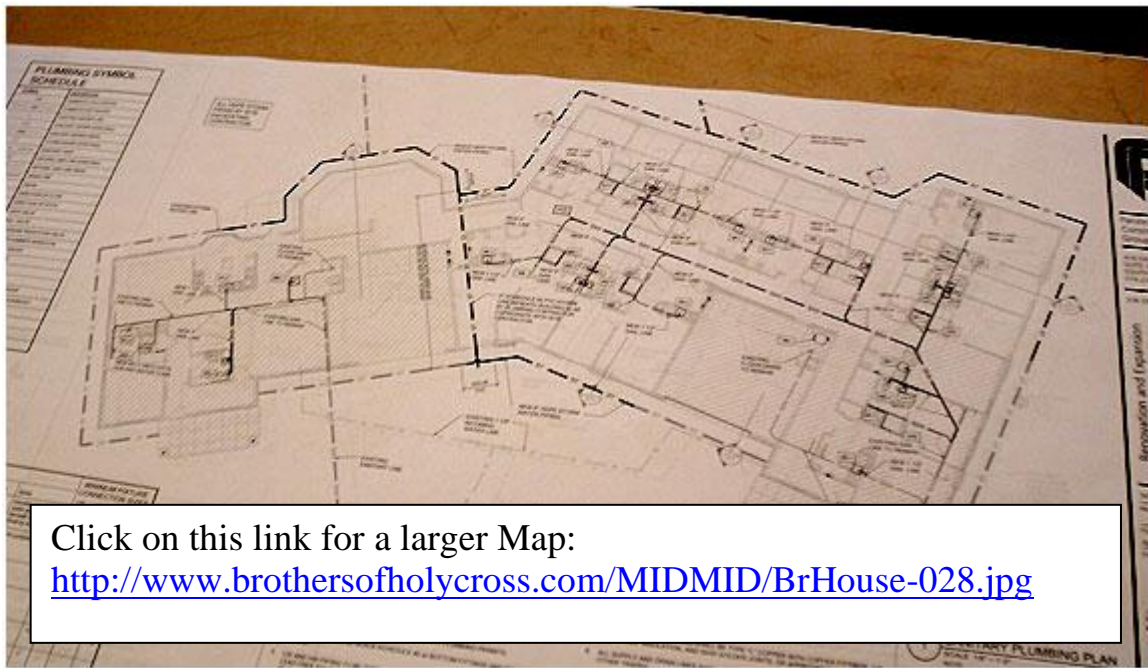
## Progress Being Made on HCV Brothers House

### Holy Cross brother's flag vigil remembered

**SOUTH BEND** — Despite temperatures rising Tuesday outside Holy Cross Village, South Bend resident Carol Napoli sat in the same place Brother Edward Courtney once sat waving her own flag to commemorate him and the country they love.

“I don’t think the heat would have bothered Brother Courtney,” Napoli said, recalling the Holy Cross brother who died in 2009.

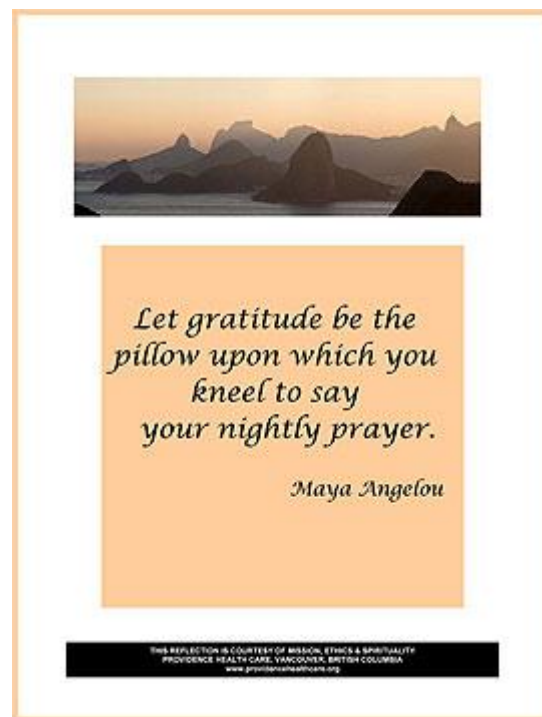
“He managed to be out here in cold weather and hot weather everyday for almost 11 years so I’m sure we can make it for an hour or two each of us.”

Courtney, a decorated war hero, began sitting outside the community everyday in 1989 after a Supreme Court ruling that flag burning was considered a form of freedom of expression.

“He got a lot of respect from people and he was really dedicated,” Napoli said. “Over the course of time, as he said in one article in The Observer (the Notre Dame student newspaper), he came to believe in the power of one individual and that it can make a difference.” ...
