Columba Hall Fire Alarms Sound Off



On Saturday evening, August 4, residents of Columba Hall were sitting on the second floor back porch overlooking the parking lot as the storm approached from the west at 55 mph. The sky was light in color from the heavy rain when at once we saw a flash of lighting and heard thunder at the same time. Our fire alarm went off for about the fourth time this year. As usual we went down to the front entrance to greet the firemen and attempted to identify the cause of the fire.

The fire box at the front door indicated it was a heat sensor in the attic. So they were off to the attic to determine what was up. After a lengthy search there was

speculation as to what it might be. Since no one was trapped in the elevator, we did not realize that it was no longer working. Firemen left the house telling us that our heat sensors in the attic were no longer working and we could rest assured that the sprinkling system was in good shape to keep us safe for the night. They said they would be back the next day with the official word and make a second trip through the house.

Brothers were discovering a few things themselves. One TV blew up and the house phone began to flash its lights and make strange noises and a few computers were fried. So we all retired for the evening resting in the fact that the fire suppression system was still working. In the morning the official report “Columba Hall had been struck by lightning” was delivered in person. As far as I know no one had looked outside at the roof and saw the real proof.
