Holy Cross College will provide a Religious Studies teacher for the Sisters' class on the Saint Mary's Campus. On Saturday Noon there was a campus-wide picnic lunch for students and parents and in the evening a reception for parents to meet each other at Andre Place.

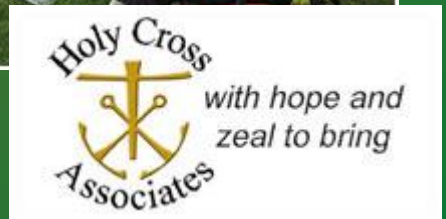
