Brother Peter Michael Graham, C.S.C.

June 28, 1941 – September 11, 2012

Brother Peter Michael Graham, C.S.C., age 71, died on September 11th at David Simpson Hospice House, in Cleveland, Ohio. He was born in Akron, Ohio on June 28, 1941, the son of William and Antonia (Tomski) Graham. He attended St. Mary's Elementary School in Akron and graduated from St. Mary's High School in 1960. He followed a calling to the religious life to join



the Holy Cross Brothers and entered Sacred Heart Juniorate in Watertown, Wisconsin in October 1960, then began his year of religious training four months later at St. Joseph's Novitiate in Rolling Prairie, Indiana, where he pronounced his first vows as a Brother of Holy Cross on January 26, 1962. Peter then moved to Austin, Texas where he began his studies at St. Edward's University and graduated with a Bachelor of Arts degree in the spring of 1965.

In the fall of 1965, he was assigned to St. Charles Boys' Home in Milwaukee, Wisconsin where he served on the faculty for a total of 11 years and was the Director of Residential Services for 4 years. In 1976, he became the Headmaster of Le Mans Academy in Rolling Prairie, Indiana where for the next 14 years he oversaw an expansion of the Academy both in enrollment and in its physical plant. In 1990, Peter joined the faculty of Gilmour Academy in Gates Mills, Ohio and was encouraged to serve as an administrator by working on boards and developing programs for parents and students through the example of Brother Charles Krupp. In 1991 he moved to Archbishop Hoban High School in Akron, Ohio to assume the role as Director of Admissions for five years and then in 1996 he became the school's Director of Development to assist in many improvements within the school for the next 5 years.

In 2001, Peter was appointed the new President of St. Edward High School in Lakewood, Ohio. Under his leadership, the school experienced a tremendous transformation, especially with the successful completion of a \$16 million masterplan which included the Kahl Student Center, the Lowe Pre-Engineering &

Technology Center, the Holy Family Chapel, new classrooms as well as innovative programs in pre-engineering and entrepreneurship studies. Brother Peter stepped down as the president of St. Edward after 10 years of successful administrative leadership in public relations, fund raising and challenging educational programs. In 2010, he served as the Vice President for Mission Effectiveness of St. Edward and then in 2011 he moved back across the city to join the administrative staff at Gilmour Academy.

There will be a funeral service at St. Edward High School for the benefit of Brother Peter Graham's friends among the St. Edward family of faculty, staff, alumni and students. It will be held on Monday, September 17 in Holy Family Chapel at the School (13500 Detroit Avenue). Visitation will occur from 5:00-7:00 pm with the Mass of Resurrection celebrated at 7:00 pm.

The funeral service at Notre Dame will be at St. Joseph's Chapel on the grounds of Holy Cross Village at Notre Dame on Tuesday, September 18 and begin with Visitation from 11:30 am to 1:00 pm. The Mass of Resurrection will then follow with interment afterward in St. Joseph's Cemetery of the Village. Kaniewski Funeral Home is handling the arrangements.


