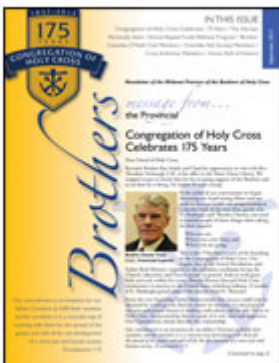
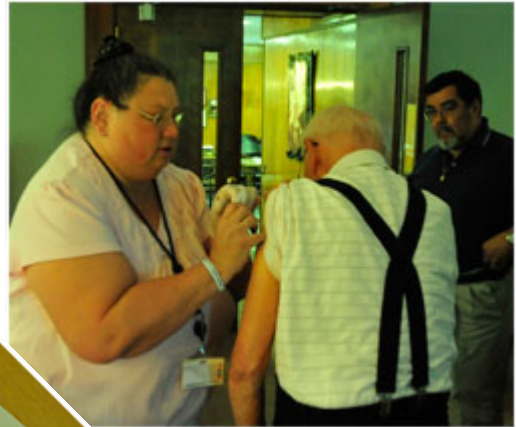


Fall Signals Flu Shots at Columba Hall
