## Br. James Leik to Receive HCC Fidelis Award at Parent-Alumni Weekend



Honoring the past as they look to the future, Holy Cross College administrators, parents, alumni, and friends of the college will celebrate the school's Catholic identity and its growth over the years from a two-year school into a four-year college. The Parent-Alumni Weekend 2013 takes place April 5-6.

The highlight of the weekend is the President's Ave Crux Dinner on Saturday evening, April 6. President **Brother John R. Paige, C.S.C.**, will present the "Fidelis Award" to four contributors of Holy Cross College, honoring "lives lived in faith."

Jack and Margaret Berges, John and Mary Anne Hardesty, Lucille and Richard McKenna and **Brother James Leik, C.S.C.**, are this year's Fidelis honorees. ## Reminder of Congregational Day of Fasting and Almsgiving

As previously announced, the three provinces in the United States agreed on Friday, March 15 as the Congregational Day of Fasting, Prayer and Almsgiving.

Below is a document sharing suggestions from **Fr. Peter Rocca** about how to integrate the intent of this Day of Fasting into the Liturgy of the Hours. It is recommended that we have common morning & evening prayer for the day. There are two suggested manners. First, the usual prayer for the day can be used with the following adaptations:

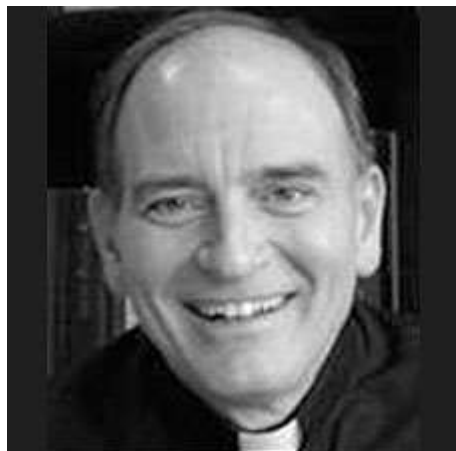
*Before Morning Prayer begins, the leader reminds the community that today will be observed as a Congregational Day of Fasting and that all monies collected will go toward assisting Holy Cross religious ministering to the street children in Bangalore, India. The hymns chosen for Lauds and Vespers might reflect the theme of social concern (e.g., The Harvest of Justice [Gather, #513] or God, Who Stretched the Spangled Heavens [Worship, #648]. In place of the concluding prayer at Lauds, the prayer "For the Congregation of Holy Cross/" taken from the Directory of Devotional Prayer, #50, could be used; at Vespers, the concluding prayer, "For the Poor and the Oppressed" (Directory of Devotional Prayer, #80), would be appropriate. These prayers could be said either by the leader alone or by all together.*

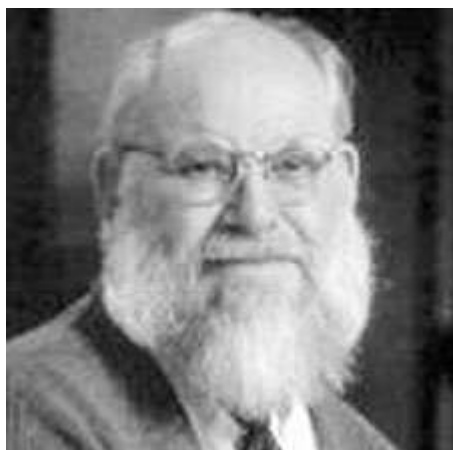
