

Br. Chester Freel Visits Archbishop and Bishops of Goaso and Sunyani



Brother Donald Becker, CSC, has been laid to rest in Wari Christian cemetery Thursday, April 25. Archbishop Patrick D'Rozario was the main celebrant. Most Rev. Michael R'Rozario (Emeritus bishop of Khulna), Most Rev. Theotonius Gomes (auxiliary bishop of Dhaka), several CSC priests were concelebrating with the Archbishop. Many religious, candidates, former students, friends and well-wishers of Br. Donald were present.

Brother Bikash V. D'Rozario gave the eulogy just before the Mass. Several people spoke on Donald and his life as a religious, especially of his contributions in the field of technical education in Bangladesh.

After the Mass of the Resurrection, the body was carried by the staff of St. Joseph Trades School (where Donald spent many years of his life). Most Rev. Theotonius led the prayers for the burial.

On behalf of the Province, I'd like to convey my sincere thanks and gratitude to you all for your continued support and prayer over the past several weeks since Donald's hospitalization.

Editor's Note: **Brother Donald Becker, C.S.C.,** age 81, died suddenly on April 24, 2013 in Dhaka, Bangladesh after a lengthy illness. He was originally a member of the Midwest Province, but in 1989 he officially joined the St. Joseph Province in Bangladesh. Brother Donald died one day after his 81st birthday. He joined the Brothers of Holy Cross and entered St. Joseph Novitiate, Rolling Prairie, Indiana on February 1, 1951 and made his first profession of vows on February 2, 1952.

Brother Edwin Reggio, C.S.C. died at Dujarie House, Notre Dame, Indiana on Wednesday, April 24. He had been a resident of Dujarie for a short period of time.

Brother Edwin Reggio, a member of the Moreau Province of the Congregation of Holy Cross, served in a variety of ministries over his long career as a Brother of Holy Cross. He taught at St. Thomas Aquinas School in Brooklyn, New York; at St. Edward's High School in Austin, Texas; and at St. Edward's University in Austin, Texas. He also served as a Holy Cross vocation promoter and as a regional director of Families for Prayer. Returning to New Orleans in 1984, he served as Headmaster and local superior at Holy Cross School. In 1991, he moved back to Austin where he served as Events Coordinator (1991-1999) and Auxiliary Services Coordinator (1999-2013) at St. Edward's University. From 1997-2003, he served as the religious superior of the St. Joseph Hall community.

Friday, May 3: the Mass of Christian Burial will be offered at 10:30

a.m., followed by burial at Assumption Cemetery.
