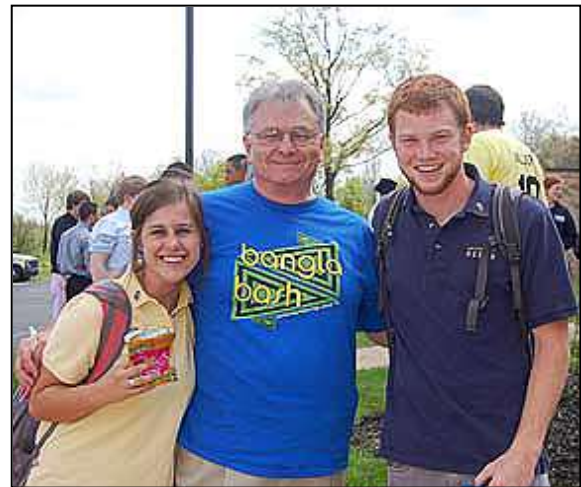




Hoban's Banglabash Raises Over \$12,000 for Holy Cross Mission Schools
