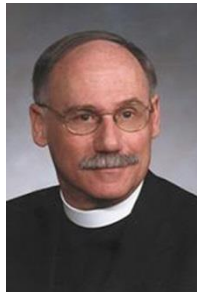

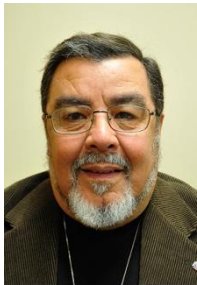

The Midwest Province of the Brothers of Holy Cross on Saturday, June 21 will honor 12 Brothers of the Midwest Province who have lived the vows of a Holy Cross religious for 60 and 50 years, along with a Holy Cross Priest who will celebrate 50 years of religious vows, and a Brother from the Moreau Province of Brothers celebrating 50 years.

The fourteen religious have a total of 750 years living the vows of poverty, chastity and obedience. Five Brothers have served 60-years, they are: **Brothers James Everett, John Ptaszek, Douglas Roach, Thomas Rock and Paul Rosonke**. Brothers being honored for 50 years as vowed religious include: **Brothers James Blaszak, Francis Boylan, David Martin, Donald Morrison, Peter Nault, Carlos Parrilla, James Reddy and John Paige** of the Moreau Province. **Reverend Andre' Le'veille'**, chaplain at Holy Cross Village, will be celebrant and homilist at the Mass of Thanksgiving at Sacred Heart Basilica at 2:00 p.m. Father Andre' was a member of the Brothers of Holy Cross when he took his vows 50 years ago.

Brother Chester Freel, Provincial Superior of the Brothers, will accept the renewal of vows by the group. **Brother Daniel Kane** of Gates Mills, OH, will direct the music and **Brother Joseph Fox** will coordinate the jubilee celebration including the dinner for invited guests which will follow Mass in the North Dining Hall.
