

#### To Know is to Love

Dear Associates and Friends,

Is knowing God different from loving God? The most significant way we know God is by a faith that brings trust, a knowing that God will be with us in all of the events of our lives; good and bad, in darkness or in light. Knowing God also comes to us in our unknowing. We finite creatures can never say our knowledge of the infinite God is in any way complete, but we can say that we know God's love for us. By faith we know that God's love for us will never be taken away even in our darkest hours.

Mother Teresa experienced God and knew God's will in her life when she founded a new religious community to care for the poorest of the poor. But after founding the community, the light of those early days turned to darkness. She could only know God in seeing him in the faces of those she ministered to. It was a new way of knowing. God's incarnation was happening before her eyes. "God became flesh and dwelled among her." In the love she had for the poor she was responding to God's love for her. Christ was still alive and well in her heart.




