Wednesday evening, February 15, 2017, **Brother Patrick Sopher** (Moreau Province) presented clarifications and background for the decrees and recommendations from *Proceedings of the General Chapter 2016* publication.

NEW ITEMS OR MAJOR CHANGES: GOVERNANCE

Decree 1 specifies that the Superior General and his Council will organize a simplified structure for the Congregation

The new structure will have only two levels of authority, the General Administration and a number of functional provinces.
