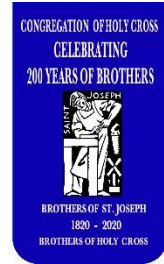

Information on individual early Brothers of St. Joseph for posting week by week in 2020.

August 16 – 22 In this week in 1792 the French Revolution suppressed all religious congregations in France. James Dujarie, founder of the Brothers, went into hiding. In 1820 on August 20 Louis Duchene became the second young man to join the Brothers of St. Joseph in Ruille.

August 23 – 29 On August 25, 1836, Brother Andre Mottais became the first of the Brothers to take Final Vows. He was novice master at Le Mans and the first of the early Brothers to persevere.

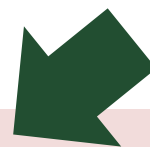

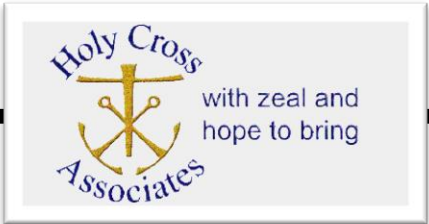
Our True self emerges when we come to know the source of our being – our creator. We do not create our own meaning. We discover it. We freely choose to be the person God has created us to be – our true self.
