Recognizing the Contribution of the Congregation of Holy Cross

E-Mail from St. Edward's University:



Dear St. Edward's University Community, Today I am announcing that The Pavilions will be renamed St. André Apartments. Later this spring, a ceremony will be held to rename and bless the building. Over the next several weeks, there will be a coordinated effort to change signage, campus maps and online content to reflect the name change.

St. André Bessette is the first member of the Congregation of Holy Cross to be declared a saint. He was canonized in October 2010 and is known for his devotion to Saint Joseph and his dedication to comforting the sick.

This name change is part of the university's long-term effort to memorialize the contribution of the Congregation of Holy Cross to St. Edward's University. The congregation founded the university in 1885. In 1945, the Brothers' Province was assigned oversight of the university, and Brother Edmund Hunt, CSC, was named the first Brother President. He was succeeded by Brother Elmo Bransby, CSC; Brother Raymond Fleck, CSC; and Brother Stephen Walsh, CSC. It is from the Congregation of Holy Cross and its founder, Blessed Basil Moreau, CSC, that the university received its mission along with the commitment to never educate the mind at the expense of the heart, to social justice and to excellence in everything we do.

St. André Apartments will join the many other buildings that currently recognize the debt our community owes to the Congregation of Holy Cross. They include Holy Cross Hall, Sorin Hall, Basil Moreau Hall, Jacques Dujarié Hall, Edmund Hunt Hall, Le Mans Hall, Fleck Hall, and the Brother Stephen Walsh, CSC, '62 Campus Ministry building.




