

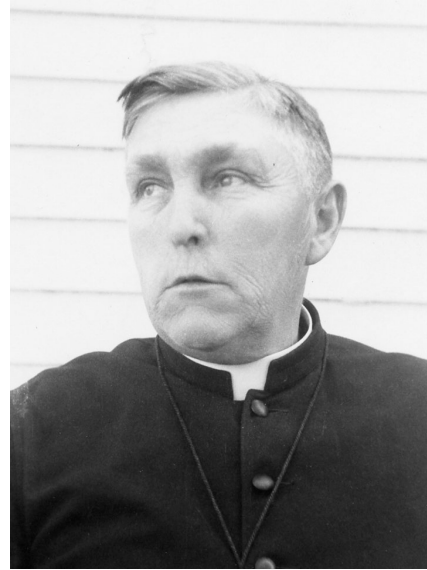

**Brother Juvian (Morit) Schwartz, C.S.C.**

*born: 6 September 1897*

*died: 20 September 1958*



Juvian was born in Cleveland and attended St. Joseph elementary school and East Technical High. He was employed at forge company and worked on a vegetable farm for 15 years. He joined Holy Cross in 1936, and went to Watertown and the novitiate where he made first vows in 1938. His first assignment was to the Foreign Mission Seminary in Washington, D.C. where he was in charge of maintenance for 7 years. He worked at the Ave Maria Press in the bindery department for 2 years. He returned to work on the grounds at the Foreign Mission Seminary. He then served as housekeeper and kitchen assistant at the Community House (Columba Hall) . In 1951, Juvian was assigned to St. Joseph's Farm where he faithfully took care of the vegetable garden and grounds. He thus returned to the same enjoyable work he had in early life before entering the Community.
