John was born in Green Bay, Wisconsin and attended school in Park Falls. He spent 5 years in the minor seminary in St. Francis, Wisconsin, and attended Columbia College in Iowa. He worked for 21 years as a salesman and control supervisor with four different companies. At the age of 49, he entered Holy Cross and went to the juniorate in Watertown in 1953. He made first profession in 1955. He worked at the Ave Maria Press for 6 years. He served on the staff at Holy Cross High in River Grove for 5 years, and then on the staff at Dujarie House and Holy Cross Brothers' Center for 8 years. In his later years of life, John weathered many serious physical crises. He had a true built-in zest for life to continue his litany of works and carry on his concern for others. John was always courteous, polite and gentle.
