Roger was born in Williamsport, Pennsylvania. He entered Holy Cross at the Juniorate at Watertown, went to St. Joseph's Novitiate at Notre Dame, and made first vows in 1927. He earned a bachelor's degree at Notre Dame in 1931 and a master's degree *cum laude* in 1938. He taught for a year at Holy Trinity in Chicago and then in New Orleans. He worked at the bookstore of Ave Maria Press, then taught at Cathedral High in Indianapolis for 3 years. In 1938, Roger began 47 years of devoted service as the Office Manager and Supervisor of the Maintenance Department for the entire University of Notre Dame. Roger was a faithful and congenial leader in his role with the Maintenance Department, a stickler for efficiency and dedicated work, particularly in the upkeep of machinery and vehicles. He lived at Columba Hall. Community members and lay friends who visited, remember the warm greeting and smile that Roger had for all, especially his co-workers and friends from the years of service at the University of Notre Dame.
