

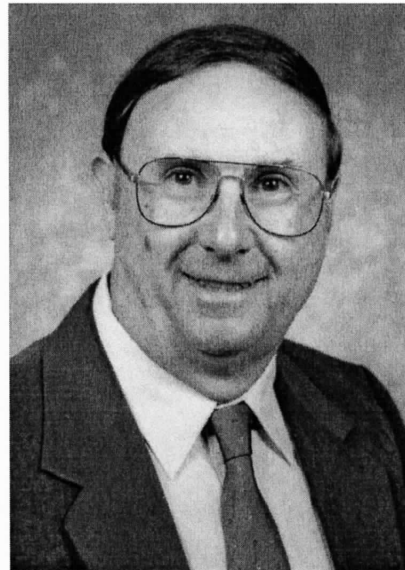

Edward was born in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania and attended St. Francis Xavier Elementary School and North Catholic High School. After graduation he worked as a statistician for 2 years and then followed a calling to the religious life. He attended the juniorate program in Valatie, New York and went to the novitiate in Rolling Prairie where he made his first vows in 1950. He studied at St. Edward's University for 2 years and then taught at Mount Carmel Elementary School in Bronx, New York. He returned to Austin to finish his studies and graduated in 1954. He taught at schools in New Orleans, Bronx, New York, South Bend, Holy Trinity in Chicago, Gilmour Academy, Le Mans Academy and Holy Cross in River Grove, Illinois. In 1976 he joined the faculty at St. Edward High in Lakewood, Ohio where he served in the library for 26 years. He retired to Columba Hall in 2002 and moved to Schubert Villa and Dujarie House in 2013. He was a very conscientious person, neat and organized. He enjoyed his daily walks knowing they were good for the body and the soul.
