### **Brother James Anthony Everett, C.S.C.**

*died: 6 May 2018*



James was born in South Bend, Indiana, the son of James and Margaret (Andrichik) Everett. He attended St. Patrick Elementary and Central Catholic High there, graduating in 1952. He was influenced by the Brothers and often helped after school and at their summer camp at Bankson Lake in Michigan. He decided to join them, by going to the juniorate and novitiate and professing first vows in 1954. He began college studies at St. Edward's University in Austin graduating in 1957. He was assigned to St. Charles Boys Home in Milwaukee where he aided and counseled students. He taught at Cathedral High in Indianapolis for 5 years and at Holy Trinity High in Chicago for 6 years. He was Director of Aspirants at Notre Dame for 7 years while also teaching and counseling at St. Joseph's High in South Bend. He was active with the "Upward Bound" program for youth in South Bend. In 1977 he went to St. Edward High School in Lakewood to serve in the counseling office and supervise the campus grounds crew. His passion was working with needy students, particularly those with ADHD problems. His cheerful interest in St. Ed's students and devotion to his "ministry of beauty" campus enterprises were shining examples of 38 years of dedicated service. He was surprised and honored by the faculty, staff and administration when the football stadium was dedicated in his name.
