Under Ohio's state aid to education program, which provides approximately \$25 per pupil annually for augmenting expenditures on equipment, educational materials, and specialized personnel, Hoban High School is using a portion of its allocation for hiring teacher aides. Brother Theophilus Machalinski is the first teacher aide to be put on the payroll of the Akron Board of Education and assigned to duty at Hoban: reading themes, correcting tests, cataloging visual materials, and serving the faculty generally.

A grant of \$16,900 from PROJECT RENEWAL of the Archdiocese of Chicago has enabled needed tuck-pointing and caulking to begin on the Holy Trinity High School Building. The work should be completed soon.

Brother Celestis Mueller is preparing a manual for use by sacristans. If any have helpful hints, pass them along to him.

Brother Viator Grzeskowiak has been named Educational Consultant for the Mission of Our Lady of Mercy by the Archdiocese of Chicago.

During the Christmas holidays, the Brothers at Bishop David High School, Louisville, were assisted in their study of the Constitutions by Brother Lawrence Miller and Brother Edmund Hunt. The Brothers were enthusiastic over the experience they had and recommend it to other houses.

Brother Bonaventure Foley has been assigned responsibility for preparing the CODE OF PROCEDURES to be followed at the Provincial Chapter of 1970. He will also prepare a suggested formula for determining membership in the Chapter.

The principals from ten of the province schools met at the Provincial House on January 3, 1969, to consider common school matters: enrollment trends, tuition, general financing, personnel, general policies. Minutes of the meeting will be distributed to the houses when they are finalized.

The Psychodynamics of Renewal Workshop, postponed because of the illness of Dr. Noland, has been re-scheduled for January 17-19, 1969. The opening session will begin at 4 p.m. There is space for four persons if any are interested.
