MINUTES PRELIMINARY MEETING 1970 PROVINCIAL CHAPTER: January 2-3, 1970

The first general assembly opened in the provincial residence chapter room at 10 a.m. on January 2, 1970, with all present except Brothers James Sullivan and John Barrett. A special prayer, composed by Brother James Moroney, opened the session.

In his opening remarks Brother Charles Krupp, Provincial, noted that the representation was the most democratic in the history of the Brothers, since elected delegates outnumber ex-officio members. He further noted that the provisional agenda was the result of consultation with province members by the steering committee.

Brother Charles next outlined the objectives of the 1970 Provincial Chapter:

1. To give direction to the province within the context of the constitutions and statutes of the congregation;
2. To engage all members of the province in study and deep consideration of what is appropriate to us as Brothers of Holy Cross today in order to better understand the ultimately express our role before God and our fellow men;
3. To evaluate our life and work;
4. To legislate where required by the constitutions.

In commenting on these objectives, Brother Charles pointed out the necessity of direction being given by the chapter so as to avoid reacting to circumstances and conditions which could be anticipated. While the new constitutions give us considerable direction, he felt that the members of the province want a confirmation from within, one that is ours, as well as some elaboration where this is necessary, since the provinces are left much latitude in implementing the constitutions. He also urged the chapter members to engage the members of the province in the work of the chapter since much of the success of the chapter will depend upon the degree to which this is done.

After the opening statement by Brother Charles, the members broke up into committees to select committee chairmen, divide into subcommittees, and to begin consideration of the agenda assigned to each committee. Committee work occupied chapter members the rest of Friday and Saturday morning. The second general assembly met at 1:15 p.m. on Saturday, January 3.

The first matter considered at this session was settling on an opening date for the chapter. Brother Charles outlined three reasons for opening around Easter:

1. To restimulate interest in the work of the chapter;
2. To give the entire province a progress report on the work up to that time;
3. To afford the chapter time for consultation with province members before the final session in June.

Members voted to open the chapter with an evening Mass on Thursday, April 2, 1970. Chapter sessions will be held on Friday, Saturday and Sunday, April 3, 4, 5. The June session will open on June 8, 1970.

The next item for consideration was the Code of Procedures. Several suggested changes were made in the proposed Code for incorporation into the final document which will be adopted at the April meeting. A final decision was to invite the scholastics at James Hall to design an appropriate liturgy for the opening Mass on April 2.

The Steering Committee, which is responsible for the over-all direction and good order of the chapter, met three times on Saturday, January 3. Members of this committee are: Brothers Charles Krupp, president; James Moroney, secretary; Jerome Chandler, Walter Davenport, Francis Englert, Bonaventure Foley, Pedro Haering, Douglas Roach, Kieran Ryan, and James Sullivan.

Decisions taken by the Steering Committee were these:

1. To suggest to the chapter Brothers Sigismund Danielski and Evan Schmid as non-capitulant secretaries.
2. To approve a proposal by Brother Pedro to add temporarily professed to the chapter as advisors. Five temporarily professed Brothers will be elected as non-voting members. They will be free to attend committee meetings, to express views of the younger members, and to speak at the general sessions of the chapter.
3. Since several committees are planning to visit the various houses to further involve province membership in the chapter, the Steering Committee will coordinate these visits to prevent unnecessary overlapping of the work of the various committees.

The next session of the Steering Committee is January 30 at 7:30 p.m.

Chapter members exhibited a high degree of enthusiasm and dedication to the work of the chapter at this preliminary meeting, and it is hoped that this spirit will be carried back to the individual houses and communicated to each member of the province.
