A native of Pittsfield, MA, David Farrell studied in public schools and then political science at Williams College before entering the Congregation of Holy Cross in 1961. He has degrees in philosophy from Stonehill College, theology from la Pontificia Universidad Catolica en Santiago, Chile, and was ordained a priest in 1968. Fr. David received a Masters of Science in sociology with special reference to education from the University of London in 1983. King's College awarded Fr. David a degree of Doctor Honoris Causus in 1995.

Last week from the Lenten Series talks.

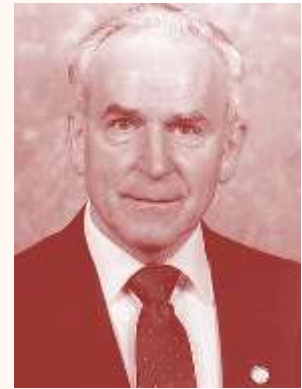

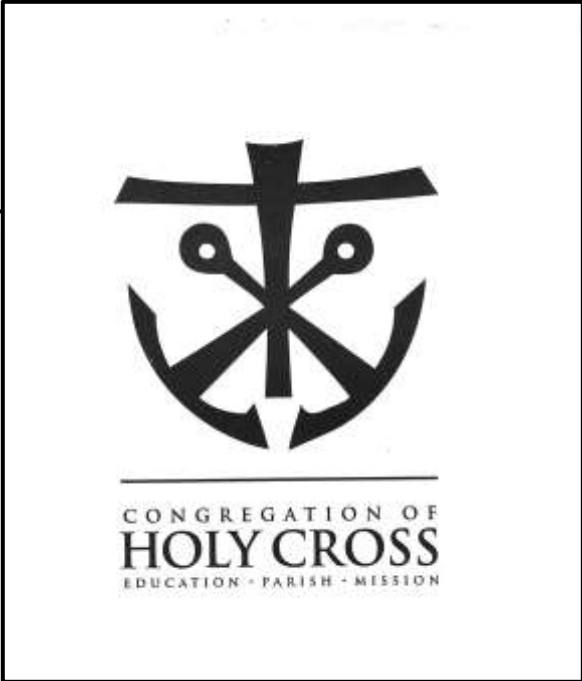
