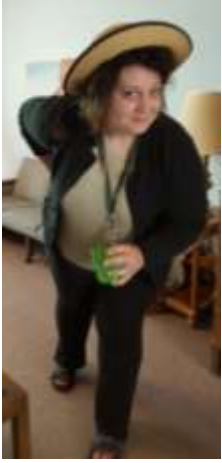



A Blessing for Nurses
