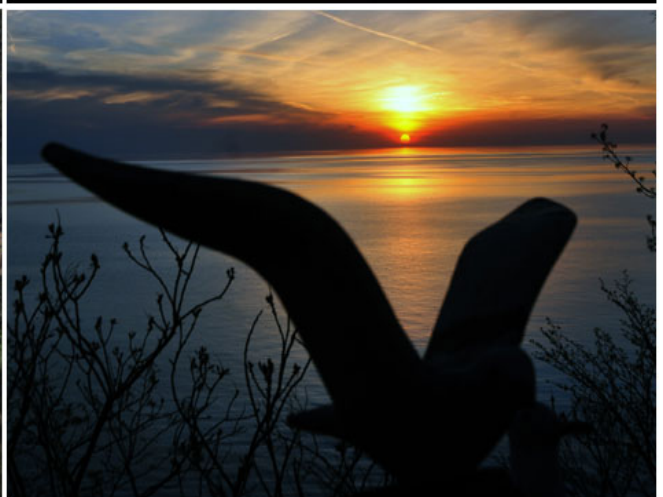

Since 1841, Brothers of Holy Cross have lived and worked on their beautiful wooded tract perched high above the St. Joseph River near Notre Dame, ministering to people of northern Indiana and around the world. In recent decades that legacy has culminated in the creation of Holy Cross College and the adjacent continuing care retirement community called Holy Cross Village at Notre Dame, offering seniors independent living villa homes and apartment options, plus assisted living, skilled nursing care and rehabilitation therapies.

The Brothers' faith-based heritage is joyfully celebrated at Holy Cross Village, where Brothers still reside in community with lay residents. In 2007, Panzica expanded Schubert Villa assisted living apartments while building a new chapel and the newest independent living apartment building; Andre Place. In 2010, Panzica renovated the independent living apartment building, known as Riverside Place, welcoming new lay residents to join the Brothers already residing there.

In 2012, Panzica and Holy Cross Village together embarked upon yet another endeavor, creating a new residential option by combining two existing single-family villas into a congregate home for seven active and semi-retired Brothers. This ensures that all current residents continue to enjoy the Brothers loving presence at the very heart of the campus, making Holy Cross Village a truly interdependent community, energized by Holy Cross' spirituality and dedicated to providing a nurturing environment focused on dignity and respect for religious and lay people alike.
