Fine Day for an Afternoon Concert



On Sunday afternoon, June 19, **Brother Daniel Kane** gave a piano recital in LaBar Hall at the O’Neill School of Music, Notre Dame. The program began with “Air on the G String” by J.S. Bach and was followed by a lush Chopin nocturne. Then Brother Daniel picked up the pace with a sprightly Mozart sonata (#15) and ended the first half of the program with Debussy’s “Clair de Lune,” a signature piece for Brother Daniel.

After a brief intermission, Brother Daniel returned to give the enthusiastic audience a wild Scherzo by Chopin—in D flat. Playing on a nine-foot Steinway grand piano, Brother Daniel really got wonderful excitement out of the Chopin Scherzo. The audience was wildly appreciative and responded with a standing ovation. For an encore, Brother Daniel gave them an evocative waltz.

Many members of the audience (two busloads) came from Holy Cross Village where they have come to know Brother Daniel from his playing the organ at their Sunday Masses.

Brother Daniel trained in piano performance at DePaul University in Chicago many years ago, but his keyboard performance has remained youthful. Recently he gave a piano recital at Gilmour Academy in Gates Mills, Ohio, where he taught for many years before retiring at Columba Hall, Notre Dame.

A Helping Hand

One of the most effective ways of praying when we are faced with situations which are beyond our control is to pray with the word “HELP.” This becomes a prayer to God that admits we are not in control and that we are putting our complete trust in God.
