**October 18 – 24** On October 22 in 1820 Andre Mottais showed up at Ruille to becoming the 3rd recruit for the Brothers. He was Primary Director of the Brothers until 1835 when the Brothers moved to Le Mans.

**October 25 – 31** On October 26, 1843, Brother Anselm wrote to Father Moreau about the miserable conditions at the school in Vincennes, Indiana.

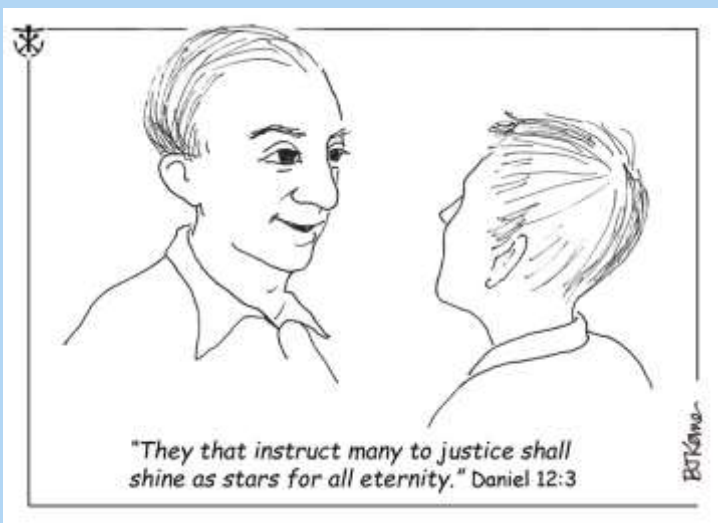

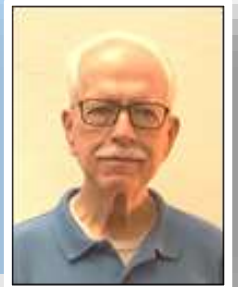
