

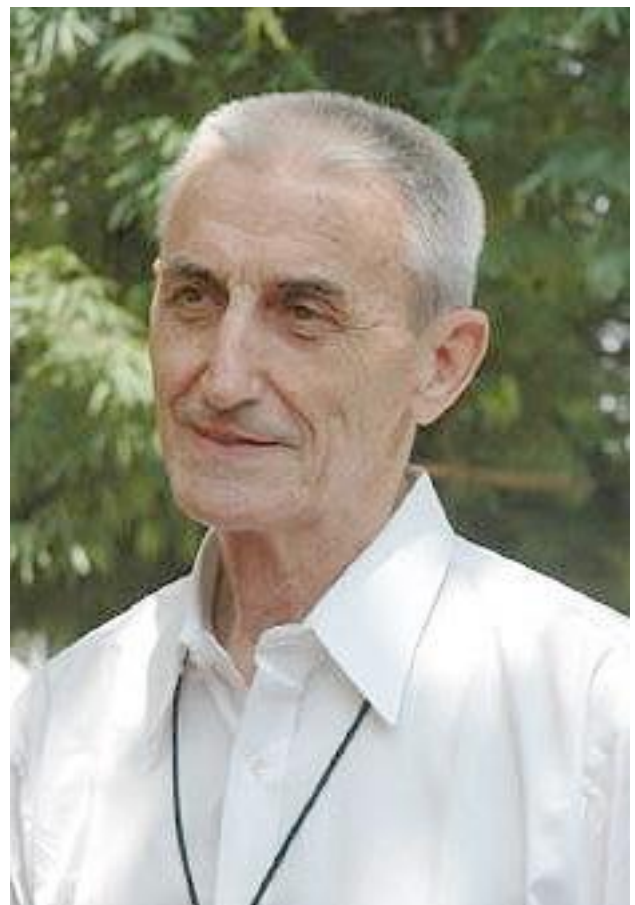

## Lifetime Achievement Award

On December 14, 2018, an International Society of Substance Use Professionals (ISSUP) jointly hosted an international conference with the **National Authority for the Campaign Against Alcohol and Drug Abuse (NACADA)** and the **African Union**. The event took place over the course of a week with 1600 participants from more than 80 countries, including more than 40 African states. **Brother Ronald Frederick Drahozal, CSC**, was honored with a plaque for his lifetime achievement. Brother Paul Mensah was present for the conference and accepted the plaque on behalf of Brother Ronald.

Brother Ronald Drahozal, CSC, the founder of Asokti Punorbashon Nibash (APON) and the former Executive Director of BARACA, was selected to receive the “Drug Demand Reduction Lifetime Achievement Award” by the International Society of Substance Use Professionals (ISSUP) for his services in this particular field. The services to Drug Demand Reduction Award honors individuals for their outstanding contribution to drug demand reduction at the local, national, or international level. Brother Ronald was one of those individuals who had unquestionably fulfilled all necessary requirements for this category.

It is very sad that he could not personally receive the award because he died on October 15, 2018 at Notre Dame, Indiana, due to kidney failure. Brother Francis Boylan, CSC, and Brother Paul Mensah, CSC, from the Congregational District of West Africa received the award on behalf of Brother Ronald on Friday, December 14, 2018. The award was given in an award giving ceremony which took place during the annual conference of the ISSUP in an Amphitheatre at Kenyatta International Convention Center (KICC), Harambee Avenue, Nairobi, Kenya.


