Brother Peter Scott Nault, C.S.C.

Born in Marquette, MI, Peter Nault attended St. John's elementary school and St. Paul's High School in Ishpeming, MI. Learning about the Congregation of Holy Cross through an advertisement in *Our Sunday Visitor*, Peter entered the congregation and earned a bachelor of arts degree from St. Edward's University in Austin, TX. He did graduate work at the University of Notre Dame and Cleveland State University. Peter was assigned to St. Edward High School in Lakewood, OH and then moved to Holy Cross High School in River Grove, IL for one year. He returned to St. Edward where he taught English and also served in a variety of other roles: assistant principal, treasurer, supervisor of the maintenance and general plant manager. "I have always treasured these 20 years in secondary education. "They were a great preparation for my second Holy Cross ministerial journey." Openness to the will of the Holy Spirit led to Peter's ministry in the Diocese of Venice, FL. First as the Assistant Treasurer of the diocese and then as Parish Administrator at the Cathedral of the Epiphany, Peter ministered in Venice for 33 years. He retired from his work with the diocese in 2019, remaining in Venice until his death.
